## Missouri Public Service and West Plains Energy Kansas move to SPP 7/1/2005

Southwest Power Pool (SPP) has filed to include Aquila Networks – WPK (WPEK), Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P facilities in the SPP regional tariff. The planned effective date of this action is July 1, 2005.

On July 1, 2005 Missouri Public Service (MPS) and West Plains Energy Kansas (WPEK) will not longer participate as Transmission Providers under the MAPP Schedule F tariff. Service to or from MPS and WPEK will require SPP transmission service. MAPP Schedule F will model MPS and WPEK as control areas and require the use of a border point for service to or from these control areas.
